**Irvine Valley College (IVC)** and its **Advanced Technology Education Park (ATEP)** in Tustin, are pleased to announce a new partnership with **California's Employment Training Panel (ETP)** to **provide financial assistance** to California businesses in support of customized worker training.

**IVC/ATEP** received a grant award in January 2011 to help employers offset the cost of training workforce.

### **Funding Overview**

You may be eligible to receive reimbursements of 50% to 75% of the costs for Advance Workforce Training with State funding. Certain conditions and limitations apply. If you are an employer looking to add knowledge and skills to your organization, contact us today to learn how state funding could benefit you!

### **Employee Eligibility**

- Frontline workers or Supervisors/Managers (no senior executives)
- Full-time workers (35+ hours per week)
- Receive a minimum of 8 hours of instructor-led training/lab training (up to 200 hrs)
- Must be retained on the job for 90-days following completion of training
- Earn at least \$14.87 per hour (base wage + the value of company-paid medical benefits - measured at end of retention period)
- Employee must not be enrolled in another ETP training program through another contractor during the past 90 days
- Employee must not be currently enrolled in a work share program
